As Cambodia embarks on a historic Davis Cup debut, NagaWorld is proud to partner with the Tennis Federation of Cambodia in sponsoring the Cambodian National Team.

Cambodia earned the right to play in one of the Oldest and most Prestigious Team Competitions in the World after the International Tennis Federation elevated the Tennis Federation of Cambodia (TFC) to a B Class Membership at the annual general meeting in Bangkok last year. The Davis Cup is the world's largest annual international team competition in sport, with 130 nations entering in 2011. Cambodia is placed in the Asia Oceania Group IV in a cluster of 10 countries that include Bahrain, Iraq, Jordan, Myanmar, Qatar, Singapore, Saudi Arabia, Turkmenistan and the United Arab Emirates. The five team groupings for the Doha Leg are yet to be announced for this round-robin stage out of which two countries move up to Group III in 2013. This is the first time in the annals of Cambodian sports that a national team finds a place in an international tournament proper apart from the multi-discipline games like the Asiad or the Olympics.

NagaWorld has been a TFC partner since 2011 backing several on going initiatives and is honoured to support the national team in this historic moment.
